Complaint by s 47F [REDACTED]

I refer to s 47F [REDACTED] complaint about Mountain Medical Centre (MMC), alleging that MMC interfered with s [REDACTED] privacy by improperly using and disclosing s [REDACTED] personal information and by failing to keep 47 [REDACTED] personal information secure.

The Office of the Australian Information Commissioner (OAIC) investigated s 47F [REDACTED] allegations under s 40(1) of the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth) (the Act).

Section 41(1)(a) of the Act gives the Information Commissioner the discretion not to investigate a complaint if he is satisfied that the act or practice complained about is not an interference with privacy, as defined in the Act.

On 5 August 2015 the OAIC formed the view that MMC had not interfered with s 47F [REDACTED] privacy. s 47F [REDACTED] was given an opportunity to comment, however s [REDACTED] did not provide any information that changed the OAIC's view of this matter.

For this reason, I have decided under s 41(1)(a) of the Act to cease our investigation on the grounds that, in my view, MMC has not interfered with s 47F [REDACTED] privacy. The file is now closed.
